Every Day Is Independence Day!



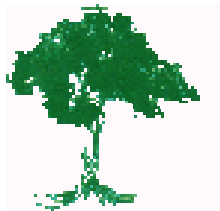
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Transition services are those that assist individuals with disabilities in moving from one phase of their life into another. The Center provides transition services to two distinct groups of individuals with disabilities.

Services are also available for those individuals who are in danger of being institutionalized but want to remain living in their community.
