Transition services are those that assist individuals with disabilities in moving from one phase of their life into another.

The Catskill Center for Independence provides **transition services** to students with disabilities as they move from high school to higher education, employment, or other activities of adult living in the community.

### The Round T-Able

The Center has also developed a “Round T-Able” Program especially designed to assist transitioning students with the skills and knowledge necessary to enable them to succeed in post-secondary education and employment such as self-determination and self-advocacy skills, how working will affect benefits, work readiness programs, available assistive technology and much, much more.

The program is available through identified school systems to students with disabilities. Contact the Center to find out how your school can become involved.
